

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

YOUR AGREEMENT WITH THOMAS HOGAN TRAVEL, INC.

Please thoroughly review these terms and conditions of Thomas Hogan Travel, Inc. and ThomasHoganVacations.com, herein referred to as THT. The booking passenger, by accepting this receipt and making payment to THT, acknowledges that they have been advised of, reviewed, and hereby accept these terms and conditions and contract for travel related services. These conditions apply to yourself, your family or traveling companions that you represent or make payments on their behalf.

THT offers retail travel services to customers, which are provided by separate and independent vendors of travel services. We do not operate, control, or otherwise provide the services of the independent travel vendors. THT acts only as a sales agent for any airline, hotel, car-rental company, ground operator, tour operator, cruise line, shore excursion, attractions, or other travel Suppliers who provide goods or services for the passenger(s) trip.

THT does not assume responsibility for and shall not be liable for any refund, personal injury, property damage, or other loss, accident, delay, inconvenience, or irregularity which may be caused by: (1) any defaults, wrongful or negligent acts, or omissions of the Suppliers; (2) any defect in or failure of any vehicle, craft, equipment, or instrumentality owned, operated, or otherwise used or provided by the Suppliers; or (3) any wrongful or negligent acts or omissions on the part of any other party not under our control. Suppliers reserve the right to deviate from the direct, customary and/or scheduled route or itinerary for any reason, without limitation and without notice. Passenger(s) acknowledge and agree that THT is not responsible for Supplier deviations, delays, cancellations, mandated overnight stays, missed connections or any other condition beyond its control.

Force Majeure: “Force Majeure” means, in relation to THT, any circumstances beyond the reasonable control of THT, (including, but without limitation, acts of God, explosion, flood, forceful wind, fire or accident, war or threat of war declared or undeclared, acts of terrorism, sabotage, riots, strikes, civil disturbance, requisition, sickness, quarantine, government intervention, weather conditions, defects in machinery and vehicles, delay, wildlife, or other untoward occurrences). THT shall not be liable for any loss or damage incurred by you as a consequence of any of the Suppliers being unable to perform its obligations due to the unusual or unforeseeable circumstances (a “force majeure event”) beyond the control of the party affected by the force majeure event.

Prices are not subject to increase after you make full payment; however, a price increase may apply due to changes in transportation costs, e.g. fuel, or any other Government imposed increases.

Power of Attorney: As our client, you hereby appoint THT to be your attorneys-in-fact for the purpose of signing all documents necessary to purchase and issue airline tickets, tours, cruises, insurance, and hotel guarantees. You authorize any of the attorneys-in-fact to authorize credit card authorizations for said purchases whenever any of them receives an online, phone, or email booking request reasonably believed to be from you or someone acting on your behalf, requesting travel arrangements be charged to this credit card account. You agree that you will pay for all such purchases and will not hold us responsible for any of our actions pursuant to this power of attorney.

Electronic or handwritten signature: Both parties agree that you may acknowledge and agree to these Terms: (a) electronically; (b) by handwritten signature; (c) by any other electronic means, including without limitation acknowledgement via email acceptance of these Terms; or (d) by your implied consent deemed via your actions which shall include without limitation the payment of the invoice and/ or your use of the services provided by THT or any other travel supplier related to your booking. All such means will be deemed to constitute effective acknowledgement and execution of this Agreement and shall be sufficient to bind the parties to the terms and conditions of this agreement.

Travel insurance protection is strongly recommended. As your travel agent, we have a professional responsibility to recommend the purchase of travel insurance to cover certain risks inherent in travel to protect against THIRD PARTY SUPPLIER DEFAULT/BANKRUPTCY PROTECTION, DELAY, INTERRUPTION, CANCELLATION, MEDICAL EMERGENCY TRANSPORTATION/EVACUATION & REPATRIATION, BAGGAGE & PERSONAL EFFECTS/LOST LUGGAGE & BAGGAGE DELAY, ILLNESS, ACCIDENTAL DEATH AND DISABILITY, TRAVEL ACCIDENT/SICKNESS MEDICAL EXPENSES, AND MORE. PROPER INSURANCE MAY PROTECT YOU FROM FINANCIAL LOSS IN ALMOST ALL CIRCUMSTANCES. By declining appropriate travel insurance, passenger(s) acknowledges and accepts liability for any cancellation penalties, damages and/or out-of-pocket expenses incurred.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

Proof of Citizenship: Passports are strongly recommended for each guest and must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your return date of travel. In the absence of a passport, a passport card or certified birth certificate **AND** a government issued photo ID will be accepted, but restrictions will apply. For further details, please go to the US Department of State website: www.getyouhome.gov. Passport applications can be found at www.travel.state.gov/passport.

Vaccination Requirements: Until further notice, all Royal Caribbean guests age 12 and older must present proof of COVID-19 vaccination.

PAYMENT SCHEDULE: A deposit of \$350 per person is required to confirm your reservation. Final payment is required on or before October 17, 2022. Credit card payments should be phoned in to our office: (843) 626-9998, Monday-Friday, 8:30am-4:30pm.

CANCELLATION PENALTIES: Port taxes and gratuities are refundable. The beverage package is refundable up to 24 hours prior to sailing. Royal Caribbean will impose penalties as follows.

November 14-28, 2022	25% of the cruise fare
November 29-December 12, 2022	50% of the cruise fare
December 13, 2022-January 11, 2023	75% of the cruise fare
January 12, 2023 and beyond	100% of the cruise fare

In addition to Royal Caribbean's penalties, \$100 per person is non-refundable from the time of deposit. An additional event fee of \$250 per person will apply for any cancellations made after October 17, 2022.

NAME CHANGES: Names may be changed prior to sailing provided one of the original names remains on the reservation.

CANCELLATION/TRIP INSURANCE: Thomas Hogan Travel recommends purchasing Allianz Global Assistance to protect your vacation investment. We have secured group rates that are based solely on the total trip cost, not the age of the traveler. Contact Thomas Hogan Travel for a quote.

GUEST SPECIAL NEEDS: PLEASE notify Thomas Hogan Travel of any special needs that may require additional arrangements while sailing. The information you provide will assist us, so far as is reasonably possible, in catering for any special requests. This includes, but is not limited to CPAP machines, dietary restrictions, wheelchair assistance, pregnancy, etc.

DINING ASSIGNMENTS: Thomas Hogan Travel will make every effort to confirm your dining requests. The choices are Early Dining at 6:00pm, Late Dining at 8:30pm, or My Time Dining. My Time Dining allows the flexibility to dine any time during dinner hours, according to time's availability.

SCHEDULE OF EVENTS: Guests will receive exclusive access to all of our private events. A schedule of events will be provided at our "Meet and Greet" party on the day of embarkation. The time and location will be confirmed just prior to sailing.

ONLINE REGISTRATION: Due to regulations imposed by the Department of Homeland Security, each guest is required to provide the cruise line with information regarding their citizenship and immigration status. PRE-CRUISE HOTEL: Thomas Hogan Travel plans to organize hotel accommodations in Port Canaveral for February 10, 2023. Rates will be available February 2022.
